2. Pre-Interview Screening:

Companies conducted an initial screening of resumes and shortlisted candidates based on qualifications, skills, and experience.

3. Written Tests:

Ankit Pulp and Board Pvt. Ltd. companies conducted offline written tests to assess technical knowledge and problem-solving abilities. [Attachment 1.]

4. Interviews:

The interviews were conducted in both group and one-on-one formats. A total of 117 students attended the interviews. The interviews focused on technical skills, aptitude, and soft skills such as communication and teamwork.
